NATIONAL ACADEMY OF TRADE UNION RESEARCH AND EDUCATION 130th WORKSHOP ON LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME AT PATIALA WING FROM 26TH TO 28TH JANUARY, 2018 CONCLUDED SUCCESSFULLY

Comrades, it was yet another mile stone in the history of our Chandigarh Circle Association and National Academy of Trade Union Research and Education (NATURE), a wing of AISBOF which has taken up a series of training programmes for the benefit of our members across the country. The programme at the wing of NATURE at Patiala was the 130th programme.

2. Comrades, the 3 days Leadership Development Program for our comrades of Chandigarh Circle Association was formally inaugurated by Com Deepak Sharma, General Secretary of SBIOA, Chandigarh Circle.
